

POSTCARD PROCESS

- CCMN delivers the postcard package to you Friday, March 19, with the number of custom postcards you have requested and literature
- Hold your postcard drive before April, if possible (please encourage people to legibly print or write their name, address and email)
- Sort postcards by legislator: a handy guide is enclosed with a website
- Return the sorted postcards to one of the following three locations or call Ted Frazer (704) 532-6854

- CCMN will enter the cards into a database and a list from your church, by legislator, will be created for your church community. This will be emailed and/or mailed to you. In addition, an email list will be created for each local legislator.
- Legislative visits are being planned for April 11th through May 9th, to which these postcards will be taken and a list of constituents in favor of the moratorium presented to each legislator. We will email each legislator's constituent the date, time and place of this meeting, and invite them to come.
- Reports will be created for each legislator visited, with a brief summary of our visit. The report will be emailed to all constituents who have signed a postcard. Note: if the constituent does not have email, we are asking the church to send a copy via the U.S. mail.
- The final report will be sent to all postcard signers by email on how their legislator voted in May and June. Again, we ask each church to mail copies of the report to those in your congregation who do not have email.
